



#### **Coupon Policy**

**We will not accept any coupon for more than \$4.99 without manager approval.**

**We accept Manufacturer's coupons under the following conditions:**

- Coupon must be of valid date
- One coupon per purchased item
- Purchased item must be as listed on coupon, specific size and quantity
- Coupon is not disallowed via the fraudulent coupon information.
- We do reserve the right to refuse coupons for which the manufacturer will not \*reimburse. You can check the validity of a coupon on several websites (<http://www.couponinformationcenter.com>).

#### **DOUBLE COUPON POLICY**

**We will double the value of a Manufacturer's coupon up to and including 50 cents with the following conditions:**

- Store coupons will not be doubled
- One coupon per purchased item
- Purchased item must be as listed on coupon, specific size and quantity
- Coupons for free items are not doubled
- If coupon states "do not double" coupon will not be doubled
- Tobacco coupons are never doubled
- If double coupon amount exceeds the retail of the item, coupon will not be doubled. Doubled amount may be equal to, but not exceed the amount of the item purchased. If doubled amount exceeds the retail of the item, only face value will be given.
- Limit of 20 double coupons per customer

#### **INTERNET COUPON POLICY**

**We will accept online coupons under the same conditions listed above, with 2 additions due to the high incident of fraud regarding these coupons.**

- Internet coupons will be inspected for industry standard specific serial numbers and date requirements; and will be rejected if not present/valid
- We will not accept internet coupons for free items

#### **FRAUDULENT COUPONS**

Fraudulent coupons are an ongoing problem for retailers and customers. Many online coupon sites do not take responsibility for the validity of posted coupons. We understand that it is often difficult to spot a fraudulent coupon and most customers do not intend to defraud their local grocery store.
